We will leave school at the earlier time of 8:30 a.m. on Wednesday 11th October and head off to Bodmin Steam Railway! We shall board the specially chartered steam train at 10:00 a.m. and experience what it would have been like to have been evacuated at the beginning of World War II. After our journey deep into the countryside, we shall walk to Lanhydrock House, where we will be met by an evacuation officer or maybe even the Lord of the manor! Hopefully we will be able to find a safe place to stay, and explore!

To enter into the spirit of the day, we are asking the children to wear 1940s style clothes (more to follow), together with a small carry bag/suitcase (with a war-time-style packed lunch - Spam sandwiches perhaps?! ©), a gas-mask box tied with string to go around the neck together with a name tag! If you have any concerns about clothing/ accessories, do come and see me. We will be returning to school at the later time of approximately 4:30 p.m.

In order for the trip to go ahead, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £8. If this causes a problem, please do come and see us.

It should prove to be an exciting and very 'real' experience, something which they will never forget!
