The trip will take place on 28th March. We will be ticking off one of our '50 things,' travelling across the Royal Albert Bridge on the train! We will need to be in school earlier than usual by 8:20am so we will have enough time to walk down to the station and catch the 9.35am train to Plymouth.

Weather permitting, we will leave the 21st Century behind us and embark on a Tudor trail around the city, before having our packed lunches on the Hoe, where Sir Francis Drake famously finished a game of bowls as the Spanish fleet headed northwards to Plymouth! Following this, we shall make our way up to the university to be taken back in time to 16th Century Illyria (modern day Croatia) and sit back and enjoy the trials and tribulations of this Shakespearian classic! We can't wait! 😊

We aim to catch the 3.57pm train home, which will mean we will be returning after school has finished. If you would like to collect your child from Saltash station, then please let me know in advance (see below), so I can organise the children accordingly. If you wish for your child to walk home, I will need written permission in advance please as well as indicating below. The rest of the children will walk back to school with us aiming to get back by 4.45pm. The children will need to be picked up, or walk home as usual.

The children will need to wear school uniform and comfortable shoes; there will be a fair bit of walking! They will also need to bring a raincoat, a packed lunch and any medication they require e.g. asthma inhalers etc.
