I said yesterday that I would send you some 'time word problems'... and here they are! I got stuck on the theme of travel! The answers will follow shortly! :-)
> *Time Word Problems - Tackle each step at a time... (ha ha, no pun intended!); draw pictures to help if you need to!

1. Hollie rides a unicorn to Edinburgh from Saltash. She sets off at 09:48 in the morning and arrives at 11:37 due to the immense speed of the unicorn. How long was her journey?
2. Luke travels by helicopter to Bristol. He sets off at 08:29. The journey is 2 hours 52 minutes long. His friend Charlie sailed a boat there and arrives 18 minutes earlier than Luke. At what time does Charlie arrive?
3. Aya skipped all the way to Cardiff, smiling as she went. Her journey takes her 2 hours and 41 minutes. She arrives at 11:25. What time did she set off? Her friend Evie set off to Cardiff 15 minutes after Aya, also skipping and smiling! At what time did Evie set off?
4. On holiday, Charlotte rides an alpaca to Camborne. She sets off at 14:27 and arrives at 17:09. However, she had to stop on the way for 22 minutes to feed the alpaca. How long would her journey have been if not for the stop?
5. William climbs up Heatree climbing tower. The climb takes him a staggering 3 hours and 33 minutes! He then spends 20 minutes at the top recovering. After this, he climbs down the tower again, which takes him a further 1 hour 41 minutes. If he arrives at the bottom of the tower at 16:35, at what time did he start his journey up the tower?
6. Brandon goes shark diving in the Caribbean. He sets off to the reef at 10:18. The journey to the reef takes him 26 minutes. When he arrives, he goes shark diving for 3 hours 43 minutes before being swallowed whole by a shark. At what time does his diving experience end?
7. Whilst on holiday on the moon, Isaac decides to go on a moonbuggy ride. He sets off at 14:36 and his ride goes on for 1 hour and 36 minutes before getting stuck in a crater. When does his ride to come to an end? If the sun sets at 17:09, how long has he got to get back to base before the sun sets and he freezes like an icepole?
8. Spencer decided to walk to London for fun.

When he sets off, his watch tells him that it is $10: 24$. His walk is 2 hours 28 minutes long before a policeman stops him and says that his walk is against government guidlines currently, and he must turn around and stay in doors! However, after discussing the time with the policeman, he finds that his watch is 11 minutes fast. At what time does he get stopped?
9. Harry went on a guided tour of The Dust Museum - A History of Dust and Dirt, which lasted $23 / 4$ hours. He completed his tour and collapsed from boredom at 14:31. It took him 39 minutes to be persuaded by his friend David that it would be good idea. At what time did David start persuading Harry?
10. Nieve, an internationally famous acrobat completes a tightrope walk across Niagara Falls. She sets off at 09:21. The walk would normally take her 1 hour 47 minutes, but on her way across she stops for a bite to eat for 27 minutes. At what time does she arrive at the other end of the tightrope?

## 11. Tyler decides to abseil down Big Ben,

delivering emergency packs of toilet rolls to the nation. The journey down normally takes 33 minutes. However, on his way down, he stops for 18 minutes to take some photos. Eventually he arrives at the bottom. Looking at his watch, he sees that it is now 12:15. At what time did he set off?

How was that?! Easy?... Tricky?...
Somewhere in the middle? Did you need some help or did you manage to do it on your own? If you found it tricky, go through some again with a parent or an older sibling to see if it helps.
