## LITERACY

Today we are practicing our sentence writing. Have a go at this bitesize lesson Capital letters - Year 1 - P2 - English - Catch Up Lessons - Home Learning with BBC Bitesize - BBC Bitesize

You may want to look at your writing from yesterday and with a different colour pen see if you used capital letters in all the right places.

Today we are going to estimate and then use our super counting in 5's and 10's to count the things. Can you put a large amount of lego/pasta/small toys on the floor. How many do you think there are? Have an estimate - do you remember its like a guess.

Now have a go at grouping them into 5's or 10's. How many do you have altogether?

You could repeat this as many times as you want – it's all good practise.

This afternoon we will be going out in the woods. I will be hiding some different cones and giving the children a map of the woods to find them. Can you draw a map of your house and then hide some teddies? Maybe you can get your grown up to find them or they can hide them for you and you can use the map to find them. This skill is called orienteering.
