Have a go at filling and emptying lots of different containers. Can you explain what you are doing and use words like more, less, full, half full, half empty?

It is our last weather chart week. How has the weather changed? what kinds of weather have we had? Would the weather have been the same or different over Christmas? I have attached some sheets with some children who need the right clothes for the season. You can cut out their clothes and get them dressed!
