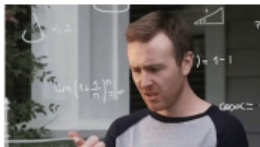

## Remember

IF YOU HAD THE NUMBER 5, 3 AND 15, WHAT WOULD THE FACT FAMILY BE?



## Answer

$$5 \times 3 = 15$$

$$3 \times 5 = 15$$

$$15 \div 3 = 5$$

$$15 \div 5 = 3$$

Be a detective and use your noticing power to look for words in the wordsearch.



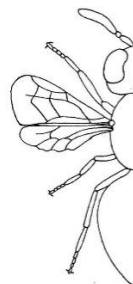
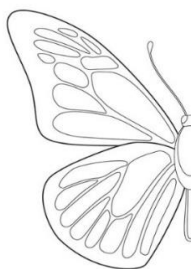
## Art

In previous learning, we looked at symmetry. Remember, if you fold the image in half it will be identical on both sides.

If you have some paint and a piece of paper, fold the paper in half and paint one half of a butterfly. When this is done, fold over the paper to create a symmetrical butterfly. You could try this with other insects. Eg ladybird, bee, wasp, spider.



If you don't have paint, have a go at drawing one half and copying the other side to create symmetry. I have also downloaded half of a butterfly and a fly picture in case you would like to use this to draw and colour the other half. This could also be used if you would like to paint it to create a symmetrical butterfly.



If you have some baking ingredients at home, perhaps you could bake some buns and use your creativity to decorate them with insects. These are decorated out of coloured icing and sweets.
