Can you find something that is big but very light and then something that is small but very heavy!!!! It is a bit strange as sometimes we think that big things will always be heavy and small things will always be light.

Have some fun playing games involving hiding and seeking.

Maybe:

- Play hide and seek: indoors or outside (if possible).

- Chop up a picture/use pieces of a simple jig-saw to find and then complete the picture!
- Place selection of items/toys on a tray. Cover them up and remove one. Look at the remaining items - which is the hidden toy?
- Make up a game of your own. 😊
