

### Get Playing...

Using puppets or any other toys you have (Power Rangers, dinosaurs, dolls...) make up a story about something going wrong in the toy's life. What could the other toys do to save the day? How could one toy make the situation better for the other?

You do not need to write this down - it's all about playing and using excellent language to make your story interesting. Perhaps you could show this to somebody at home once you have made it up.

Make a picture to show the events of Palm Sunday - you can paint, draw, collage or even make some palm leaves instead.

### Get thinking...

Draw a heart outline and write inside it some of the things that you can do to show your love and gratitude for other people who are special to you.

### Get making or baking...

Research what an Easter Simmel cake is. You can try making your own or make you own Easter Cake.

Or you can make a model Easter Garden.

### Reading & Research

Share the Easter story (Holy Week) with somebody at home.
