#### What are we doing this half term?

This half term we are starting a new topic, we will be looking at Traditional Tales and thinking about Easter. Each week we will be focusing on a different book and planning our activities around that story. This topic fits in with World Book Day (Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> March) and is based around the children's interests. They all love stories and have been particularly interested in the traditional stories.

Throughout this topic we will be developing the children's maths and literacy skills with lots of exciting activities. Each week this term will have a literacy or maths focus in keyworker time as detailed below as well as daily phonics with Sprog. We are particularly focusing on sounds we can make with our voices and bodies and for those children who are ready we will be working on letter sounds and simple words. We are all very excited about this topic and will be developing all of the ideas that the children have as we progress through the half term.
