## Times Tables

This week we will be working on multiplication and division facts for the 4 times tables. Spend some time practicing these tables at home. You can use the following websites to help you or you can practice these in a different way. If you already know these tables, try multiplying by 10 or 100. For example,  $1 \times 40$ ,  $5 \times 40$ ,  $3 \times 400$  = Try taking your tables past the 12<sup>th</sup> multiple.
