READING TIME

Physical Activity – Building a rocket using big movements.

Warm up - moving to 'fun' music in different ways - eg moving like a spaceman to "Walking on the Moon" by The Police.

Look at some pictures of Wallace and Gromit from "A Grand Day Out" (see attached or look on Google Images).

Think about building a rocket for your own space travel. Create different actions for using tools: eg saw, hammer, drill etc and then develop these into much larger movements.

Link several together to create a simple 'Rocket Building' motif.

Practise moves with some music: eg the Wallace and Gromit theme tune.
Then climb into your rocket - can you make it move?

Cool down - Tall stretches - to reach the top of the rocket and low stretches to touch the floor. Repeat with 'polishing' action so that your rocket is nice and shiny and ready for your next adventure. ☺
