This week it is based around transport.

Firstly, choose a favourite country and research into its primary mode of transport. Lots of countries have tram lines, some might use train systems, skyline or some might promote the use of bicycles. Create a fact file about the transport and its links. Is it ecologically friendly for example, does it help the environment, is it accessible to all? Etc.

Research some of the underground lines in London. Many are based on tile designs. Create your own design using a mosaic tile effect. You can either do this using pencils, paints or tiles (depending on what you have at home). You could emulate tiles by cutting up coloured card. Let your imaginations flow. ☺ Link for information:
