Please can we ask for your help?

Over the last few weeks staff have reported minor damage to their cars in the car park. Having looked on the CCTV we can see that at the beginning and end of the day children are being allowed to run around the cars and some are on scooters. Please can we ask parents and carers to ensure that children are closely supervised – this is primarily for their own safety.

Similarly, may we remind parents and carers that NO CARS or VEHICLES should be entering or leaving the car park between the hours of 8.40 – 9.10 am and 2.50 – 3.30 pm. If you have a disabled badge we ask that you still abide by these rules and arrive early and leave after the children have left the area. There are a lot of 'free-range' children in this area at these times and their safety is paramount.
