You can do this either on good old fashioned paper and colouring pens, or on a computer.

I'm Looking for these things:

- Historical accuracy (make sure your info is correct. You could research the same information from different sources (books, Wikipedia, internet searches, TV documentaries etc.) to see if they match or contrast.
- Well written text (think how we improved sentences last week!) which makes sense and is proofread and edited as you go.
- Artwork to enhance your work and give it that 'umph' you are aiming for! (If you use a computer, leave blank spaces for you to draw pictures!) As you know how to draw faces correctly now too, you could use those skills to draw some mini portraits! 😊
- Some interesting facts that you are drawn to! Enjoy!

You have **5 days** to do this, so space it out...there are 6 people altogether (5 main ones!)
