## Maths

Today I would like you to try and use the expanded vertical method for addition.

**Expanded** vertical

$$336 + 63 = 399$$

300	50	6
+	60	3
<hr/>		
300	110	9

We had a go at this in class together on Monday. If you find this tricky, try partitioning the numbers like this:

$$43 + 25 = 68$$

$$\begin{array}{r} / \quad \backslash \quad / \quad \backslash \\ 40 \quad 3 \quad 20 \quad 5 \end{array}$$

$$40 + 20 = 60$$

$$3 + 5 = 8$$

$$60 + 8 = 68$$

Either throw a dice to make some numbers yourself (3 digits + 2 digits) or you can log onto Mathletics - Go onto the bar which says 'Add and subtract - review'. Complete some of the adding tasks to do. If you have completed this task already at home on Thursday, feel free to practice further or complete a different Mathletics activity.
