- Plain or checked blouse
- Knee/calf length traditional Austrian style skirt. We are willing to make the girls' skirts but require dark plain/plaid material. If you can donate any, that would be a great help
- Dark tights
- School shoes

- Brown/ grey leggings
- Brown/grey t-shirt (plain, no logos)
- Brown/grey tights to be made into tails
