<p>Monday -</p> <p>We have been reading the story of Dear Zoo by Rod Campbell. You may have this book at home or you can search for the story on youtube Dear Zoo read by Justin Fletcher CBeebies Bedtime Stories - YouTube</p> <p>Ask you child to tell you the story - they are really good at this! Then, can your child draw a picture of an animal and then stick a flap over the top with a label on so that they make a new page for the book.</p>	<p>Monday -</p> <p>ay</p> <p>Can you show your child this sound and then practise sounding out the words</p> <p>may say play way day spray</p>	<p>Monday -</p> <p>Todays lesson focuses on counting backwards.</p> <p>Can you practise counting backwards.
