## Maths: Grid method for multiplication

When we were last together, we did some work on multiplication of 2 digit by 1 digit numbers. To solve these, we used a partitioning method. Today I would like you to try a new method - the grid method. This is very similar to what you have already done as you still partition the 2 digit number and work it out in the same way.

For example:

12 × 3 = <b>36</b>				
×		10	2	
3		30	6	= <u>36</u>

I have also attached a PowerPoint is you are having a little trouble with the internet or you want some further information.

Task: - There are some worksheets to do. You DO NOT need to do all of these. Choose your level of learning - there are 2 levels with questions 1-10 on each level. You will have 2 days to do this learning. I suggest the first page today and the second page tomorrow. Try not to do all in one go, as doing some tomorrow will give you a chance to practise the skills you have learnt today.
