Good morning, how did you get on yesterday? Did you make a home for some dinosaurs?

Starting off again with phonics and continuing with the y sound- re watch the video to go through the flashcards and remind you of the sound. Can you think of some words that have y in it? Have a go at reading or writing some like yak, yuk, yes and yum.

If you can, pick another game off <https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources> maybe try the dragon game (they are a bit like dinosaurs!)

In math's we are going to keep thinking about numbers but today focus on numbers 10-15. Can you have a go at recognising and writing these numbers? Make sure the 1 goes first to show it is 10, plus either 1,2,3,4 or 5! Once you've had a try can you count out 10-15 items from a larger group?

To keep your bodies moving let's do some GoNoodle videos ('All I eat is pizza' is a class favorite song) find these on Youtube by searching GoNoodle and pick 3 songs to dance along with.

Thinking again about our topic of dinosaurs lets do some art this afternoon. Think about what dinosaurs looked like, below are some examples. Can you have a go at drawing, painting or even making your own dinosaur? See what materials you can find. Maybe you could have a long-neck dinosaur like a Diplodocus, sharp teeth like a T-Rex or feathers like a Velociraptor?
