In maths can you practice reciting numbers 0-20? Then see if you can count a group of 5, 10, 15 and even 20 objects! This could be using anything such as pens, coins or books.

In the afternoon (weather depending!) can you make a dinosaur home outside? See what natural materials you can find to make a shelter. Is it a large dinosaur like a brachiosaurus or small like a velociraptor? Make the shelter to try and keep it safe from other dinosaurs.
