This week in school.....

This week in Reception, we have enjoyed lots of special activities as we celebrate our last full week of the school year! The children loved the Teddy Bears' Picnic, the KS1 water fight, and watching the Year 6 Leavers' Service at church. We also enjoyed a relaxing spa afternoon on Friday to celebrate all of our achievements. We have made the most of the sunny weather and have been thinking ahead to Year 1 and all the exciting adventures that await us in September! 😊

This week has been a busy one! The Year 3s have been working hard in Science learning about magnetism and friction. They have also been solving problems in Maths about statistics. They enjoyed a teddy bears picnic with the Year 4s and Years 5 out in the sunshine and also watched the Year 6 leavers assembly up at St Stephens church. At the end of the week they did an amazing class performance for the Moana production with fantastic singing and confident dancing in front of a big audience. A massive well done to all of them.

This week in Year 5, we have been busy constructing our slingshot cars. The children carefully attached the axles, wheels, and elastic bands before testing their cars to evaluate their speed, durability, and traction. It was fantastic to see them applying their problem-solving skills, making improvements and reflecting on their designs after each test. In Maths, we have consolidated our learning on multiplication and division. The children have continued to build their confidence by applying these skills to calculations and problem-solving activities.

This week year 1 have been learning about quarter, three-quarter and half turns. Been solving a maths mystery. Beating the heat by throwing some water at each other.

Year 2 have had a great week with water play, picnics as well as finishing off some topic quizzes and enjoying time together. They spent some extra time in Year 3 with Miss. Underdown and had a brilliant time. They have also been singing lots and are more than ready for the challenge of key stage 2 next Year. Well done Year 2 you are awesome!

Year 4 have thoroughly enjoyed learning about electricity in science. We have been learning about the dangers of electricity and have created beautiful posters illustrating these. We then moved onto learning about circuits, building these both practically with the components and using by a digital program on the chrome books. In our history lessons, we have been learning about Viking warriors. Linking our learning to art, we have been using the sketching techniques we have used to create amazing portraits of Viking warriors. Thinking about using a grid over this has helped us to understand the proportions on a face. Well done Year 4.

For the year 6 children, this has been an emotional last full week at Bishop Cornish, dominated by rehearsals, learning scripts and singing songs.

The start of the week saw the class busily practising their lines and their moves in order to get ready for the opening night of Moana on Thursday evening. The costumes have also all been brought in and fitted, and now only the application of the make up and the lifting of the opening night curtain remains.

On Wednesday, the children performed beautifully at their leavers' service at St Stephens Church creating a really powerful and long lasting memory for everyone who attended. This was followed up with the Year 6 BBQ at school. Thank you to everyone who brought in food and drink and volunteered their time so generously to make the event a fitting send off to all the children moving on to secondary school in September.

Year 6 should be incredibly proud of their time at Bishop Cornish and all that they have achieved whilst here. We wish them all the very best as they move on to new adventures at their new schools.

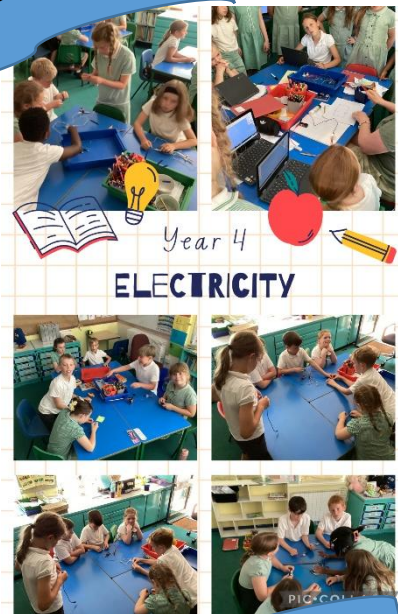
