# General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR)

As you are aware there are new regulations regarding data protection and processing coming into force and we are required to inform you of the data we hold about you and your child, how we process this and who we share it with. We will not be holding any additional data as a result of this new legislation but we do need to tell you how we ensure it is kept securely. Last night your child brought home a **Privacy Notice**, based on the Department for Education model, which provides you with important information. Keeping children safe and happy is intrinsic to all we do at Bishop Cornish. This means that all staff take part in additional training to ensure we provide the best for the children. We are delighted that 10 members of staff have just completed their Paediatric First Aid training alongside the 8 members of staff trained in Emergency First Aid and 2 members of staff trained in First Aid at Work.
