- 15 minutes spelling (Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays) and handwriting \geq (Tuesdays and Thursdays)
- Times Tables daily 15 minutes \geq
- \geq 45 minutes English (I have not given you any more, I have just given you an extra 15 minutes to complete this).
- Maths lesson 45 minutes (Again, it is the same amount, but a little longer to complete as I knew it was a rush to complete in 30 minutes)
- Topic 1 = hours
- If you complete the topic or anything in less time, you can choose to do some \geq more PE from Mr. Brown's challenges.

I know things are all still very different and this is not school as you know it, but this is the way things need to be just for a little longer.

Reading It is great that you can now access the AR system at home to read and guiz on books you are reading. I am monitoring what you are doing here as I can see the guizzes you are doing. I am so impressed as in a week, lots of you have already logged on to AR - well done. Please
