

Then, with His head bowed down, and quietly, Judas said, "It isn't me, is it?."


To this, Jesus replied, "Yes, you are the one." This made Judas feel very ashamed and worried, but luckily, the other disciples had not heard the conversation.









He broke it apart to share with everyone.
