This homework should take 25 minutes in total so if it takes you longer than that, please do stop. My suggestion is:

10 minutes – how much of the first multiplication square can you complete?

5 minutes – practise the ones you found tricky.

10 minutes – complete the 2nd square – how many can you achieve in ten minutes?

- If you complete the multiplication square very quickly, spend the rest of the time practicing your tables as multiples of 10. E.g. 20x3, 60x5 etc.
